NENAD SALJIC, CROATIA.

"When I was young, I had long fantasised about climbing the Matterhorn but I never really had the chance. The Matterhorn was the last great Alpine peak to be conquered and its first ascent in 1865 marked the end of the golden age of alpinism. Its North Face, pictured in both images, is one of the 'Three Great Problems' in the Alps and was not climbed until 1931. I have been around Zermatt countless times, the village nestled at the foot of the Matterhorn, looking toward the mountains, trying to capture the exquisiteness of this magical peak and its endless state of change. This portfolio is a kind of memento to all climbers who dared to go there and for those who never returned."
